Jennifer Carroll has a lifelong passion for helping others write, find connections, and tell stories. She is a writing coach, editor and ghostwriter with independent authors and for Traverse City-based publisher, Mission Point Press. She has coached and edited seven books by Michigan authors, including Norwood resident Charles Cleland's sequel to Adventures of a Fur Trader to be published in spring 2020.
